## Remember a Hero this Christmas

I was recently watching a television programme whilst on holiday and during the programme opinions were sought from different parts of the country. The compere said "over to Wolverhampton for comment" and the image on the screen was of the bust of a sailor. I have lived in or near Wolverhampton all of my life and was ashamed to admit I didn't know the story of this sailor or why he would represent the City of Wolverhampton.

On my return home I discovered that the tribute to this brave man is set in St Peter's gardens. The Harris Memorial remembers Able Seaman Douglas Harris, a son of this city who was born in Penn and worked in a bakery before signing up. He was on secondment to the Italian Navy ship Floandi when it came under heavy fire. Harris stuck to his post and continued sending messages and making entries in his log, until he was killed by a piece of shrapnel. He died on 15<sup>th</sup> May 1917 and does not seem to have received any award from this country, though he was posthumously given a high award by the Italians. The people of Wolverhampton did not forget him and his memorial was paid for by public subscription. This year marks the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the end of The Great War and I began wondering how many stories such as this one are remembered by descendants of these brave men and women.

The Rotary club of Wolverhampton will mark the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the end of the Great War with a storyboard situated in The Wulfrun Centre within the Rotary Remembrance area.
